- Scripture: Phil 2: 5-11
- ♦ Paul starts with "let the mind be in you...which was also in Christ"
- ★Four specific characters of Jesus' in this passage:
- 1 . Mind of transparency
- 2. Mind of self denial
- 3[.]Mind of obedience
- 4. Mind of humility
- ♦ all these characters are found in Jesus till he died on the cross
- do we gave these characters/mind in us??

№ சொல்லருமை ஞானரே

- 1 . Mind of transparency
- ♦ Phil 2:6,7 being in the form of God.....was made in the likeness of men
- ♦ other religions depict their God as angry gods in the form statues: but Jesus was truly a man, and he had all the emotions of man
- ♦ he felt tired, hungry, thirsty, angry (in the church when people are using it as a trade center); slept...,
- ♦ he was born, lived, died as a man ...
- ♦ no need for Jesus to prove himself to anyone; he, himself left his form of god and became truly man for us.
- many times we are hypocritical; don't want others to see our actual emotions; we hide our emotions, act hypocritically
- ♦ Is our life like an open book / transparent?
- ▶Three characters' from Bible
- 1. David
- we see this mind of transparency in King David (Psa 51:3)
- when we read this psalm, we skim through this passage so fast; if we read taking our time we will understand the mind of David
- ♦ David was reprimanded by Nathan for his sin; David, being king, didn't act high handedly; he readily accepted his sin, confessed his sin; wrote his sin in a song for everyone to read and know; didn't think about his status, what other people will think about him etc...
- ♦ Jesus expects this openness, transparency in our life

♪Yovan Palmer song :பாதகன் என் வினை தீர் ஐயா

- ♦Ps 51:3 For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me
- we may say, For I know your transgressions: and your sin is ever before me
- ♦ God is looking for David like people those who are transparent in their life; not Nathan, the accuser who finds faults in others
- can we live in complete transparency?? Is it possible all the time?
- 2. St. Paul
- ♦ I have gone through depressing thoughts about my anger, pride etc.,
- ♦ Rom 7:15-25 St. Paul too had gone through such emotions without hiding.his turmoil, he had written about that in the above passage
- ♦ less prayer, devotion time with God, black (flesh) gets stronger; and if we be closely with God, our white (spirit) gets stronger
- ▶ *Bhagavathar Sastriyar says, "We are not sinless saints but sinning saints; trying to become sinless saints"*
- none can be 100% perfect but we all should be moving towards that

- 3. Disciples
- ♦ this transparency was seen in Jesus' 12 disciples also
- when Jesus was said that one will betray him, everybody became sad and asked, "is it me"; none pointed fingers to others

MOne day at a time Jesus

- 2 Mind of self denial
- ♦ Phil 2:7 But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:
- ♦ Mark 6:24.. but to deny our self, take up the cross and follow Jesus
- we always say 'I' but should say "God willing"; Bagavathar Sastriar always says this
- expect in wedding invitation we don't see this phrase "God willing"
- ø i am trying to emulate him, fail but trying

- ♦ Phil 2:5-11
- Let the mind of Jesus be in you..

Recap

- 1. Mind of transparency
- ♦ Jesus had this transparent mind; though he was in the form of God ... he was made in the likeness of men
- King David had this (Ps 51)
- ♦ 12 Disciples of Jesus (Mark 16:18, 19) were also had the mind of transparency
- 2. Mind of self-denial
- ♦ Phil 2:7but made himself of no reputation
- ♦ Jesus didn't ask us to pray, fast, preach but the first and foremost is self-denial (Matt 16:24)

- "Know yourself" says Socrates
- Marcus says "Control yourself"
- ♦ Orient saints say, "Give yourself"
- ♦ but Jesus only said "deny yourself" in which above three is covered
- øare we self centred "I"?

3. Mind of obedience

- ♦ Phil 2:8 and became obedient unto death, even the death on the cross
- ♦ Jesus obeyed from his childhood to death: this continued till his death; he obeyed to his parents and to his father God/his will
- ♦ John 4:34 obeyed to father God
- now parents are worried about the disobedience of their children; many times we, the parents don't obey to the word of God
- ♦ Hosea 4:6 if we forget the law of God, HE will forget our children
- we aspire many things for our children; after 12th std.. we choose good profession; parents sacrifice a lot; parents follow up very meticulously; It seems that parents before few decades didn't do any sacrifice ;
- but are we concerned about their spiritual life, reading bible, going to church...?
- ♦ In our time, on Sundays we had to go to church, should not talk/ play in the church; none brought water bottles and snacks to church; we need to say a part from sermon, memorize one psalm, if not, we will not get lunch;
- And our parents never compromised on this
- ♦ why don't we do this?; you we make excuses, citing generation gap as the reason; BIBLE remain same, is it not? what changed???
- ♦ Solomon says in Prov 3:12, 22:15, 23:13,14, 29:17,
- ♦ are we compromise in our bringing up of our children; we should discipline them young, then they won't leave it in their old age
- ♦ if we forget the law of God... he will forget our children

- ♦ Num 12:3, 7; Heb 3:2
- Moses was very humble/meek; who is faithful in all mine house
- ♦ Exo 32:15 God gave tablets to Moses, in which the commandments were written; Moses broke the tablets in anger/frustration; in this instance God didn't get angry because Moses had shown zealous for God
- ♦ Num 20:11,12 God asked Moses to speak to the rock for water but when frustrated Moses smote the rock; he disobeyed God; God got angry

- ♦ Deut 3:25-27 God denied him entry to Canaan; Moses begged God to forgive and allow him to enter to the good land beyond Jordan.... God didn't compromise
- are we obeying God?? Our God is Almighty, loving yet he will come back as judge;

4. Mind of humility

- ♦ Phil 2: 8 And being found in fashion as a man, He humbled himself.,,
- whatever he preached, he practiced; whatever he practiced, he preached
- ♦ John 13:14,15 Jesus started washing the feet of his disciples; ..., he set an example for us to follow
- do we have this humbleness
- Abraham, the patriarch of Israelites, says in Gene 18:27, he is ash and dust
- David who is after the heart of God, says in Psalms that he is a worm
- Paul, who has written 13 epistles, scholar, lived a humble life
- can we grow in humbleness? Yeah, Paul did grow, so can we
- Paul says:
- AD 59 1 Corin 15:9 I am not worthy to be called as an apostle
- ♦AD 64 Eph 3:8 less than least of all saints
- ♦AD 69 1 Timoth 1:15 I am chief among all sinners
- have we seen any one declared like this? This shows St. Paul's growth in humility
- Many show their humility in dressing, eating, speech, walking; but what God expects...,,
- ♦ Matt 5:3 humble in spirit will inherit kingdom of God
- od we have this humbleness? God looks our heart:
- we take pride in our education, position, status, caste, beauty, religion, humble etc.,

- Not in mouth but in life
- Not in lips but in life

- ▶What is the outcome of this types of mind in him, God exalted him

★ Obedience

PAD 1874 - A Tirunelveli Hindu priest's 9 year old son was given a vision of cross and given a covenant promise Ps 22:30; his generations are called to worship; 7th generation Sastriyar Sarah Martin is with us; Martins took voluntary retirement from work to do full time ministry; we are doing ministry for 24 years;

- ♦ Matt 21: 28 32
- This was told to chief priests, scribes, etc.,
- ♦ A man had two sons and asked his first son to go to vineyard; he answered and said I will not; the father was sad; he came to Second son and asked the same, he said I go sir; but went not
- ♦ two different characters; first son *afterward* he repented and obeyed the father
- all good teachers ask questions to know how much they understand
- ♦ Jesus asked which of two did the will of his father?? They answered the first
- right answers get appreciation from teachers;
- ♦ here, instead of appreciating, he said the publicans and harlots go into the kingdom of God; why so??
- Jesus said in this story about two type of people:
- People whose words are better than their actions (Second son)
- ♦ his second son stood with all respect and answered affirmative
- made his father happy; pleased his father by words
- ♦ In Jesus' time and in Old Testament time such people were there
- ♦ Matt 23:3 do what Pharisees and Scribes bid you to observe.....
- ♦ Isa 29:13 ... draw near me with their mouth.... removed their heart from far from me
- *one minister went to share the gospel in a village; he saw a wood cutter.. Started sharing
 the gospel while the wood cutter was working very hard almost for 2 hours; lunch time came;
 he stopped his work and had gone to eat, even invited the minister also; Now the minister
 asked whether he wanted to accept Jesus; perplexed the wood cutter asked," who is
 Jesus??" I worked hard for 2 hours, you didn't help me... I don't want such Jesus; How
 pathetic
- ♦*St.Francis of Assisi said, "preach the gospel at all times, if necessary use words*

2. People whose actions are better than words (first son)

- ♠ Matt 21: 38 he answered "I will not":
- he humiliated his father in front of all; hurt him by words
- ♦ thieves, harlots, tax collectors hurt others by harsh words and actions
- but some tax collectors changed their life after they encountered Jesus; Matthew, Zacchaeus are such examples
- partial obedience (second son) and delayed obedience (first son)
- both their obedience are not complete; in this age also we see such people
- some are like first, hurt others by words but do many charity works;
- there are many non-Christians who obey in words and actions
- ♦ In 2004, Nagapattinam was affected by tsunami, government did good works; one non-Christian widow lost her 6 year old son... got govt. help of 1 lakh; she went to meet the collector to returned the money because her son came back; what a faithful non-Christian widow....
- another news two ministers who cheated the money collected for tsunami were arrested.... pathetic
- ₱Who obeyed the will of the father?
- ◆delayed obedience is disobedience & partial obedience is also disobedience
- * *correct/right obedience* should be done immediately and completely
- \$1 Corinthians 4:20 not in word but in power
- \$1John 3:18- action and faith

★ Jesus' Compassion

- ♠ Mark 8: 1-9
- ♦ Jesus fed 4000 with 7 loaves of bread and few fishes, happened in Decapolis, left overs were taken in 7 baskets; disciples brought the loaves of breads and fishes

♦ Mark 6:35-44 - another occasion where Jesus fed people; this near the desert of Galilee; 5000 were fed; 5 loaves of bread and two fishes; remaining were collected in 12 baskets

(These two were different incidents, within a period of 6 months)

- before analysing the miracles, it is essential to understand two facts:
- 1. Compassion of Christ
- ♦ Mark 8:2 Jesus said,"I have compassion on the multitude"; compassion is different from sympathy, empathy, pity etc.,
- In Galilee also he moved in compassion
- why so much emphasis on compassion?;*Compassion means love in action*
- ; *compassion is, your pain in my heart*; we can feel sorry for others... but showing that in action is important
- compassion was the driving force for Jesus
- ♦ Wherever Jesus did his miracles, he was moved by compassion
- ♦ Mark 1:41 Jesus, moved with compassion
- Leper Jesus touched him and healed him
- ♦ Luke 7: 13 had compassion on her...
- Nain's widow's son was raised from death
- ♦ Matt 20:30,34 Jesus had compassion on them
- two blind men's vision restored
- Mark 8: 1-9; Jesus moved seeing multitudes and he moved for single person also
- ♦ the peak/climax of his compassion is, his death on the cross

- 2.) Confusion of disciples
- ♦ Mark 8:4 ... from where a man can satisfy these men with bread here in wilderness?
- same disciples had witnessed similar situation 6 months before....; either they forgot the incident or they had little faith, or ignorant or they didn't believe in Jesus' omnipotence
- we should remember the paths we had crossed in the past; how God walked through us in those difficult situations and God did miracles for us; we too get confused at times, we are not better than the disciples
- we ran to many ministers and ministries for all our problems and difficulties; we think that their prayers will be answered; wrong; where is our faith??? We need to kneel down in the altar and pray for ourselves
- ♦ Hannah was insulted by her sister in law, she went to the altar to pray, not to Eli, priest of that time
- her prayers were answered;
- ♦ There is no mediators between us and God
- ◆ 1 Timothy 2:5,6 ...one mediator between God and men
- ♦ the disciples brought their difficulties to Jesus and got them solved; died for Christ
- let us also go to our Lord in prayers for all our needs

1. Centurion's love Luke 7: 2 Centurion's servant, who was dear to him nothing will get affected if one servant die; government will give him another one in our earlier days of letter writing, we start our letters with Dear, to whom we love; this servant was dear unto him think, in our home, place, office, we too have servants; have we ever prayed for them in our prayer groups; it doesn't strike us we take efforts for our friends and relatives but not for servants are we showing true to love to others Jesus did miracles for multitudes and for a single soul; heaven rejoices when one soul gets saved climax of love is cross

2. Centurion's witness

♦Luke 7: 4,5

he did't know that Jesus is the messiah; but he lived a witness life;

- ♦ Jesus witnessed Jesus said, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel

we all need

3. Centurion's humility

- \$Luke 7: 6 Lord trouble not thyself, for I am not worthy...
- He was an Army General, high status, Roman...
- \$Luke 7:4 but the Jewish elders say, He is worthy for whom you should do this
- he was gentile, an idol worshipper, not prayerful etc., but he was very humble
- many show their humility in dressing, eating, walking, speech, but Jesus expects humility in our spirit
- ♦ Matt 5:3 Blessed are the poor in spirit; for theirs is the kingdom of God
- ♦ how far we are humble?
- Master and Lord Jesus washed his disciples feet (John 13:14,15); how are we??
- not lips but in speech
- not in tongue but in walk
- Pharisee and publican went for prayer; publican's humble prayer was answered

(4.) Centurion's faith

- **♦**Luke 7:9
- ♦ first he sent elders of the Jews to bring Jesus to his home, then he sent his friends to ask Jesus to say a word that's enough to heal my servant; what a marvelous faith?
- ♦ but the Bethania family, Jews, who knew God, called Jesus when Lazarus was ill; and Jesus waited, Lazarus died; In John 11:21, they said, if you would have been here he would have not died..... now nothing can be done.... Thet didn't believe that Jesus can bring him back

- Jesus was surprised by the centurion's faith
- Two instances in Bible say about Jesus' surprise
- second, the unbelief of his people (Mark 6:6)

★ Answered prayers

- this is about a man with unclean spirit in Gadarenes
- ★ Three prayers from this passage:
- 1. Prayer of the demon
- 2.) Prayer of unbelievers
- (3.) Prayer of the redeemed saved/healed
- ♦ he was in the tombs, possessed by many spirits, legion, chained, he was hurting himself, unclean, not in his mind...
- a demon possessed will be like this
- ♠ Luke 22:3 demon entered to Judas
- our heart's latch is inside, if we didn't allow none can enter
- ♦ Rev 3:20 Jesus also wait for our permission; gentle God; won't force himself in
- 1. Prayer of demons
- how the demons prayed? Mark 5:6 .. he (demon) ran and worshipped;
- 1. Prostration
- 2. Proclamation (Mark 5:7)
- 3. Petition (Mark 5:12)
- what is the difference between demon and us
- ♦ *difference is, demons can't proclaim Jesus and live a witness for him*
- ♦ Jesus answered "yes" to demons' prayers (Mark 5:13); unclean spirits went out, and entered into the swine..... they were chocked in the sea

Prayer of unbelievers (Gadarenes)

- ♦ Mark 5:17

- ♦ Gadarenes were upset with Jesus for 2 reasons; first he saved this man, second 2000 swine were killed, affected their economy; so they were angry
- but Jesus was concerned about that one soul; big rejoice in the heaven whenever a soul is saved
- many times we are depressed that we are not worthy in the eyes of friends and family
- but we are all worthy in the eyes of Jesus
- ♦ Mark 5:15 -... they were afraid of him when he was in his mind; and not afraid when he was possessed by the unclean spirit; surprising!!!
- missionaries took Gospel to tribes dwelled in mountains; they are not cultured; once they are saved; education and medical attention were given, society is afraid, ironical

- ♦Mark 5:18 அப்படியே... are we pushing him out of our life or inviting him in???

3. Prayer of the redeemed (legion)

- but to him, Jesus answered "no" but then gave a command
- ♦ Mark 5: 18 ... that he might be with him
- ♦he asked him to go to thy friends and tell them how great things the Lord has done for you
- he didn't die for us in vain; we are called to proclaim Jesus
- ♦ he went to Decapolis (10 villages) and began publishing about Jesusthe first missionary sent my Jesus is this man
- ♦ Jesus didn't call us to be devotees but disciples; major difference between these two is
- devotees follow only when God is near; disciples follow him irrespective of his nearness/far
- ♦ Matt 28:16 go and make disciples....
- ♦ a man of God says, if you are satisfied with your salvation and sanctification, you are useless in His battle field

- we are not called to be devotees of Jesus but as disciples

Took him to Thanjavur, Thulasi Maharaja's court; the prince Saraboji was 7 year old; he and Vedhabothaganm were together, when he became king, he kept Vedhabothagam with him; at his age 30, God talked to him through Ps 22:30. Vedhabothagam was the first Sastriyar. You wrote most of the keerthanai songs. - ♦ John 2:11 his disciples saw the manifestation of his glory
- they were with him all the time
- we too should have continuous fellowship:
- with Jesus
- and with believers
- and with non-believers
- cordial fellowship with non-believers only bring them to Jesus
- ♦D. L. Moody had a dream, in that dream, he dreamt of going to hell, and he saw a big dining table; delicacies were kept in the table; and people were sitting around the table, but they were not able to eat because their hands were tied with a stick; all were hungry;
